In honor of our 75th anniversary of service, we pause to reflect on the history of Sevier County Electric System. From humble beginnings, SCES has grown from a small company of 3 employees serving 700 customers to a much larger operation of 100 employees serving over 55,000 customers and counting. In 1939, it would have been impossible to foresee this kind of growth in our system and in our communities.

Our location next to the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, which serves more than 10 million visitors each year, has transformed rural Sevier County into a thriving tourist destination.
