Rate Increase Effective April 1, 2008

As of April 1, 2008 TVA will increase the rate on what it charges SCES for electricity by 10 percent. Coupled with a \$4 flat increase on SCES's customer charge, this will equate to an overall rate increase of 12.8%. According to TVA, two of the primary reasons for the rate increase are:

- 1. The lingering effects of the 2007 drought and its continued impact on reduced hydro generation (TVA's least expensive generation source.)
- 2. To meet the growing energy demand by investing in new generating facilities and energy efficiency initiatives. (This will reduce TVA's need to purchase more costly power from other energy suppliers.)

The average SCES residential customer uses approximately 1272 kilowatt-hours of electricity per month, meaning the average bill will increase from about \$102.00 to \$115.00. Of that \$13 increase, about \$6 is from TVA's hike on electricity, approximately \$3 from TVA's Fuel Cost Adjustment increase, and the \$4 flat increase on SCES's customer charge. Actual billing amounts will vary depending upon individual usage.

Sevier County Electric System is offering our customers FREE "Do It Yourself' home energy audits. You can request the Home Survey by calling SCES at 453-2887 or online at www.energyright.com. This survey serves a dual purpose. The first is that it helps the customer find economical ways to reduce their electric bill. The second purpose is to reduce electric demand for TVA. Consumers who complete an audit will receive a personalized report that illustrates their home's energy use and cost. The report includes tips on how to cut back on electric use and reduce the electric bill. The energy efficiency kit will arrive by mail 4-6 weeks after the survey is complete. TVA estimates a savings of \$2-\$4 a month if all the contents of the kit are used. The kit includes 2 compact fluorescent light bulbs, outlet and light switch gaskets, a filter whistle, 2 faucet aerators, a hot water temperature card, and an energy use thermometer gauge. This home energy audit is a win-win situation for the customer and Sevier County Electric System. Please contact SCES for more information. Green Power is electricity generated from clean, renewable resources like wind, solar, and methane gas. Renewable resources create less waste and pollution than traditional energy such as coal, oil, and nuclear power. Purchasing two blocks of green power for one year equals the environmental benefits of planting an acre of trees in the Tennessee Valley.

Though these resources are free, the technology used to capture their energy is still expensive. Increased demand will eventually lower the cost, but until then the Green Power Switch Program relies on the cooperation and support of residential and commercial users.

For an additional \$4 on your electric bill each month, Green Power Switch can supply a "block" of green power equal to 150 kilowatt-hours of energy.

Clearing the Path & Keeping the Lights On!

Sevier County Electric System is dedicated to providing the best service possible to our customers. The majority of power outages that occur are due to tree interference. SCES trims trees for two very important reasons:

- 1. To ensure that our customers have dependable electric service
- 2. To prevent safety hazards by maintaining a 10-20 foot clearance between tree branches and the power lines. SCES requires a 10-foot clearance for hardwoods and a 20-clearance for softwoods.

SCES's tree trimming crews follow the International Society of Arboriculture standards to maintain the health of trees. Our goals are to keep customers' trees alive, healthy, and out of harm's way. The directional pruning method we use removes only the branches that pose a threat to power lines, and helps ensure that future growth is directed away from power lines. After we trim, trees are less susceptible to disease and insect problems; and because the trees are stronger, they are more resistant to high winds.

Debris caused by a severe storm is not removed. In the aftermath of a storm, SCES crews must work quickly to remove downed wire hazards and restore electricity to all customers. The crews will cut broken and uprooted trees in order to reach locations that need repair. In such emergency situations, customers are advised to contact their local Department of Public Works, trash collector, or a professional tree-removal company for advice on disposing of debris.

Sevier County Electric System also has a tree swap program. This program is to encourage replacing a regular trimmed tree with a Redbud or Dogwood. The new tree will be planted away from the power lines and will eliminate continued trimming.

Get off the billing Roller Coaster Try the Levelized Pay Plan

Now, there's a way to guard against large fluctuations in your monthly electric bill...without ever having to play "catch-up" at year's end. Its called Levelized billing and its designed to keep your electric bills affordable every month as long as you remain on the plan. It's the ideal way to accurately anticipate your monthly electric bill.

Levelized billing makes your electric bill predictable. Your monthly electric bill is a rolling average of your electric usage for the past 12 months, plus 1/12 of any difference between Levelized bills and actual bills.

For instance, this month's bill would be the average electric usage of the previous 11 months and this current month plus 1/12 of any difference between actual and Levelized billing.

Because Levelized billing uses a rolling average, your monthly bill will vary slightly each month. But because changes in usage are averaged in over a 12-month period, there is never a really big bite in the very cold or hot months when usage may be high.

The only time you have to reconcile is when you decide to leave SCES or no longer want to participate.

Levelized Billing Qualifications

- You must be a SCES customer for 12 months
 a same location
- 2. You must have an acceptable pay history.
- Once on the Levelized billing plan, you must keep your account current
- 4. You must sign up for Automatic Bank Draft
