There's nothing like summertime. Temperatures are climbing, and the beach is beckoning. Before you take the plunge on your summer activity, follow these important safety tips:

In the Sun

- Always use sunscreen, even on cloudy days and reapply after swimming or sweating.
- Keep babies under 6 months of age out of direct sunlight. For older children, use a sunscreen with an SPF of 15 or greater.

In a Car

- Always wear your seat belt and use car safety seats for small children and booster seats for bigger kids. Booster seats should be used until your child can correctly use a lap/shoulder seat belt.
- Make sure your car's tires are inflated properly before going on any road trip.

In the water

- Learn to swim. The American Red Cross offers courses for people of all ages.
- Never Swim Alone
- Pay attention to local weather forecasts and stop

In a Boat

- Every person on board should wear a life jacket at all times: make sure it is the right size and not too loose.
- Be aware of local weather conditions and bring a portable radio to check current weather reports. Always tell someone where you are going, who is going with you, and what time you should return.
